Emeritus Professor Chis Maxwell AM

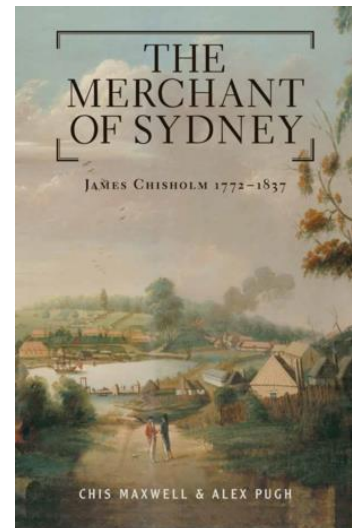
The Merchant of Sydney: James Chisholm (1772-1837)

James, among like-minded emigrants, had a vision of a society and a nation that was bigger than being just a gaol on the other side of the world. Coming from an underprivileged background in Scotland James joined the New South Wales Corps and arrived on the Britannia in 1791. After a long career as an NCO he left the army in 1810, and established himself as a merchant with significant landholdings in Sydney.

Chis Maxwell graduated from the University of Sydney (BScAgr Hons, 1974, PhD 1979). He studied animal science and specialized in domestic animal reproduction. Chis has written over 300 scientific articles in international research journals and 4 scientific books.

With Alex Pugh he has published three historical biographies: *The Merchant of Sydney* (2015), *The Master of Hell's Gates* (2017) and *The Intelligent Mr Kinghorne* (2022). *The Master of Hell's Gates* received the Lilian Watson Tasmanian History Award for 2020.

Since retirement, Chis has been involved in lay ministry at St John's Anglican Church, Beecroft. He is married with two adult children

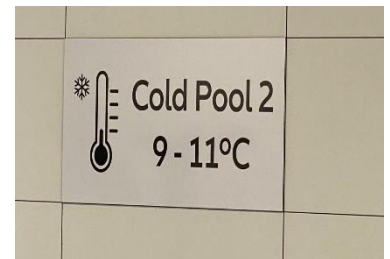
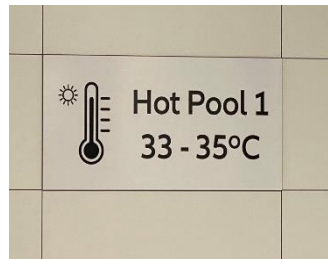

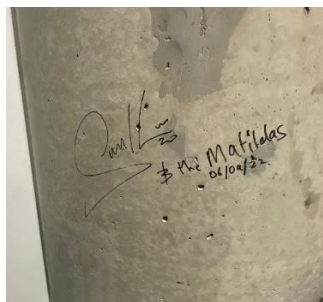
