DON NAPPER on the colonial architect James Barnet.

James Barnet

James Barnet was the longest serving Colonial Architect. During his 28 years in office, he designed and built 1,350 important public buildings all over NSW. His buildings included post offices (such as the Sydney GPO), police stations, courthouses and lock-ups and jails, as well as lighthouses, psychiatric hospitals and a number of government buildings.

A large number of Barnet's buildings are still in use today, not only in Sydney but also in rural and regional centres throughout NSW.



Don Napper was educated at Sydney and Cambridge Universities in molecular chemistry. He retired from Sydney University in 2003 as the Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Sciences & Technology) where he is an Emeritus Professor. His interest in James Barnet was triggered both by his administrative responsibility as Pro-Vice-Chancellor for the Faculty of Architecture for 6 years, his ten year experience as a guide for the Barnet-designed Macquarie Lighthouse and his friendship with the Barnet family for over fifty years.
