NEXT SPEAKER




Henry Van Zanden · 3rd

Henry is the son of Dutch migrants who emigrated to Australia in 1952 and settled in Nimmitabel. He holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree (History major), as well as a Diploma of Education from Newcastle University. He has been a high school history teacher, real estate agent and is currently a self-employed author.

Henry's talk will be on his book about the 1629 Mutiny on the Batavia.

The Batavia was built in Amsterdam in 1628, the flagship of the Dutch East India Company. On her maiden voyage on 4 June 1629, Batavia was wrecked on the Houtman Abrolhos, part of a chain of small islands off Western Australia.

What happened next is a great story of mutiny, mayhem and murder. Don't miss it.
