THE KILLER WHALES OF EDEN

The incredible, true story of the unique relationship between a pod of killer whales (Orcas) and a whaling family in Eden and Twofold Bay on the far south coast of NSW from the late 1880s until and 1930s. The killers and whalers helped, respected and trusted each other in a way never recorded elsewhere.

Many of our members will remember Graham's previous great talks – his first on the lost Geman

airmen who landed in WA, and his second talk on Bea Miles. For those members not familiar with Graham, before retirement he spent 40+ years in education as teacher, consultant, Chief of Public Relations, Principal, Inspector of Schools and Director of Education. He has a wide variety of interests including wildlife conservation, cryptozoology, folk history and the restoration of vintage microcars (or "bubblecars"), of which he owns and drives three. In 2014, he was given an award by the NSW government in recognition of his 50 years as a JP. Graham writes for several magazines and has become a popular speaker on over 30 topics at various clubs and retirement villages.
