After lunch we travel to the Berrima District Museum located in the delightful historic village of Berrima in the Southern Highlands.

This exceptional museum brings to life the history of the district. The museum's popular exhibition space, the digital gallery, has a new exhibition about the Gardens of the Southern Highlands and the people who created them, past and present.

The original hotel, known as The Commercial, was built soon after the railway line came through in 1868 and was officially licensed in 1884

The original hotel boasted "good accommodation maintaining its name The Royal until 1950, when it was finally renamed Bundanoon Hotel.

The accommodation is basic, but comfortable and has had a makeover but still maintains the old country pub feel of yesterday.
