The **Hidden Cellar** event where 20 wineries will have unlimited samples available for you to try, will be held in the tunnel of the historic and heritage-listed Coal Loader. available

A goodly number of Probus members trod the streets of Surry Hills learning about the **Murders Most Foul** there. The Darlinghurst exploration promises to be just as good and an interesting visit to the once seedy underbelly of Sydney. Tread where the vice queens of Sydney once lived, an area synonymous with prostitutes, dope dealers with drugs on offer, and notorious murders, the historic territory of the push gangs operating from the 1880s to WW1, the razor gangs of the 1920s and Depression era, and the heroin gangs of the 1970s to 1990s. Some of these characters ended up in the old Darlinghurst prison.

Lunch at the Strangers Restaurant of Parliament House followed by a guided tour is sure to be a pleasant gathering.
