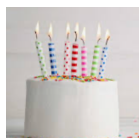

Concord Rotary Farmers Market

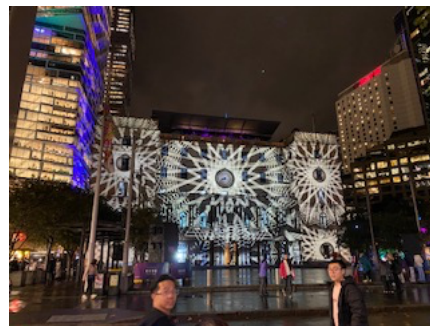
